Frequently asked questions:

Why should I consistently use Stalosan F in my herd?

The aim of Stalosan F is to assist in consistently reducing the pathogen load in the house, thereby reducing the risk of a disease outbreak.

Is Stalosan F a drying agent?

Stalosan F is primarily a disinfectant. However, Stalosan F does have a drying component and can absorb up to 4 times its weight in water.

Can I use slaked lime/ lime wash with Stalosan F?

No. Stalosan F has a pH of 3.5. Lime has a very high pH (10-12).

Can I “white wash” with Stalosan F?

No. Stalosan F should not be mixed with water or be turned into a paste. If you want to ensure Stalosan F sticks to the walls of a pen, after clean out and washing when the walls are still a little damp, Stalosan F can be blown into the pen and on the walls.

What happens if my animals eat /lick some of the Stalosan F in their bedding?

Stalosan F is safe and non-toxic to animals. No adverse effects will occur if your animals accidentally ingest a small amount of Stalosan F.

Can I use Stalosan F during a disease outbreak?

Yes. During a disease outbreak Stalosan F assists in preventing the spread of the pathogen and helps to reduce re-infection of the animal due to a high pathogen load in the bedding.

Can Stalosan F be used to reduce ammonia?

Yes. Stalosan F can assist in reducing high ammonia emissions in the house/pen.

How to Apply Stalosan F

Dosage: 50g/m²

Frequency:

- Ideal application: once every 7 days
- Prevention: Every 1.5-2 weeks depending on the health status of the animal and the moisture in the bedding. During periods of increased disease risk, revert to ideal application frequency
- Outbreak: every day for 3 consecutive days and then once per week until the disease outbreak is over
- Cryptosporidium: Every 3rd day

Large areas: Stihl SHE 71 or similar



Smaller targeted areas:

Kitchen sieve and 50g scoop or a 700g Stalosan F shaker bottle



Large – medium targeted areas: Stihl SR420 / Red Rhino mist blower or similar

Large areas focusing on the floor only:

Talon spreader or similar



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
