

Description

The GarLick Block is a unique blend of garlic compounds, salt, maize, and molasses. It allows for the easy supplementation of Garlium on the farm. When consumed by horses, ruminants, and antelope, it acts as a natural in-feed insect repelling agent.

Features

- It consists of highly concentrated *Allium* compounds together with feed raw materials to control lick intake.
- Easy to feed on farm.
- Classed as a Nutritional supplement.



Benefits

- Supplementing it in horse, ruminant, and antelope diets aids the host in repelling insects.
- Supplementing Garlium via the GarLick block can reduce the host tick load by 50 – 70%.
- Once ingested, non-metabolised garlic active ingredients are excreted via the breath and skin, surrounding the animal with a garlic aroma.
- Supplementing Garlium to lactating dairy cows **does not** influence the taste or smell of milk.

Target animals	Target intake of GarLick/Knoffel block
Horses	120 g / horse / day
Ruminants and Game weight categories:	
Less than 100 kg	30 g / animal / day
Between 100 and 300 kg	60 g / animal / day
More than 300 kg	90 - 120 g / animal / day

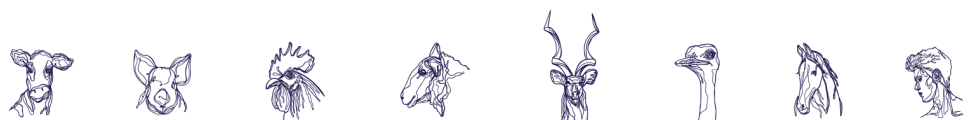
This is a lick and not a complete feed. Ensuring sufficient pasture/roughage and water must always be available. The lick does not contain any medications or additional vitamins or minerals.
