

FOOT BATH

Stalosan F is a dry contact disinfectant proven to kill bacteria, viruses, and fungi.

A foot bath is a simple and critical part of biosecurity on farm, helping to prevent the introduction and spread of a disease on farm.

Frequently asked questions:

Why use a powder foot bath?

Stalosan F foot bath allows for management ease. Stalosan F foot bath does not need to be changed daily, the concentration of the active ingredient stays consistent, and temperature and sunlight does not negatively impact the efficacy of the foot bath. Additionally, there is no moisture around the area of the foot bath.

Should I mix Stalosan F?

No. Stalosan F does not require any mixing with any other product, shavings or water.

Can I use lime with Stalosan F?

No. Stalosan F has a pH of 3.5. Lime has a very high pH (10-12).

Can I use a liquid disinfectant as a first foot bath and then Stalosan F as a 2nd foot bath?

Yes. The liquid disinfectant should have a low pH (pH range 2-4).

How long does a Stalosan F foot bath last?

1 foot bath allows for approximately 500 pairs of boots.

Where do I use the Stalosan F foot bath?

In front of animal houses/pen areas. At the entrance to offices, or other working areas.

How to use Stalosan F Foot Bath:

If boots have mud on them:

- First step in a tub of water and shake the mud off.
- Then step in the Stalosan F Footbath
